
Kajikawa Cherry Blossom Festival Place: Kajikawa Chisui Kinen Kouen (Kajikawa Flood Control Memorial Park)

Place: Oomineyama (Mount. Oomine), Road Station kajikawa



The season is here for the specialty of Niigata "Echigo hime"

March and April are season of strawberries. Have you ever tried "Echigo hime" which is the specialty of Niigata?

"Echigo hime" is the strawberry which was born in Shibata, and having features as juicy and sweet smell. Because it is cute and fresh like a princess, so it was named Echigo (old name of Niigata) hime (princess).





And a new variety of strawberry which is named "Hime no temari (hand-sized ball) was born last year. It is a special brand that has collected even bigger and sweeter kind than "Echigo hime".

You can eat it in limited term from late March to early April. Please enjoy "Echigo hime" as gifts or rewards.

*Note: It is planned to sell "Hime no temari" in supermarkets or farmers markets in Shibata around late March.

Be careful of PM2.5

PM2.5 is a substance smaller than 2.5 μm in diameter (1/1000 of 2.5 mm) floating in the atmosphere. Once inside the body, it can cause asthma and other diseases. It is produced from waste incinerators and automobile exhaust gas mainly.

Please pay attention to the amount of PM2.5 in the atmosphere it is always higher from March to May. When the amount of PM2.5 gets particularly high, the prefecture will issue a notice, so please be aware of the following things.

When you get the notice

- ▼Avoid hard exercising outside, and reducing going out as much as possible.
 - *It is effective to wear a high-performance mask when going outside.
 - Wear a mask fitting your face size so that air does not leak out.
- ▼ Changing of the air in your house must be minimized, opening and closing the windows allows the fine dust to enter.
- ▼People who are ill, small children, the elderly are damaged easily, so be especially careful.

- · Garland chrysanthemum...150g · Sesame oil...tablespoon2
- · Daikon radish...80g
- · Chirimenjako...tablespoon4 Recipe
- · Salt...teaspoon1/3
- · Roasted sesame...tablespoon1x.

- 2 Peel the daikon radish and cut into strips.
- 3 Add garland chrysanthemum and daikon radish in a bowl and mix.
- ④ Fry the chirimenjako in a frying pan and remove to a plate.
