In spring, bears wake up from hibernation. And the they actively move in search for food. When you climb a mountain or go out to pick up wild plants, take measures to avoid encountering them.

If you encounter a bear, don't make noise, don't run, and step back slowly facing the bear.

"Things to keep in mind when going out to the mountains."

You can check when and where the bear came out on the city hall website.

Hold a bell, radio, or other things that makes noise, and not to act alone.

Not too close to the place where the bear came out.
