Let's enjoy the sea of Fujitsukahama!



Fujitsukahama Beach is a swimmable sea in Shibata City.

You can swim there from Jul.13th to August 18th. There are parking lots, toilets and rest areas nearby.

Have a great summer at Fujitsukahama Beach !

Let's follow the rules for enjoying the sea.

- Warm up before entering the ocean.
- You should not swim if you have taken alcohol.
- Avoid swimming when the waves are high or the weather is bad.
- Keep an eye on children.
- Swim where you are allowed.
- Don't swim when you're not feeling well.

The Fujitsukahama beach is located within a park called Prefectural Shiunji memorial Park.

If you go there by bus, take the bus bound for “Fujitsukashama” from “Shibata Station” for 35 minutes. After getting off at the bus stop called “Fujitsukahama”. it is about a 5-minute walk to the destination.



Make use of the cooling shelter on hot days!

During the period until October 24th, on the day when a “heartstroke alert” is announced, air-conditioned areas in public facilities will be the place for everyone to comply.

Such places are called “cooling shelter”.

When you go outside, make sure to use a cooling shelter to avoid heatstroke which body becomes unwell due to fever or lack of fluids caused by heat.

Please see the table below for places that can be used as cooling shelters.
